

PROGRAM COUNCIL

The Program Council consists of the chair or contact person for each congregational standing committee, program committee and activity. Chaired by the vice president of the UUCC Board of Directors, the members of the program council meet quarterly to network with, provide support for and obtain assistance from other members, the board and the minister. Together the members of the program council work to create a sense of community among the participants of our diverse programs and activities.

In carrying out its purpose, the Program Council shall:

1. Meet four times each year. The suggested meeting schedule is October, January, April and July.
2. Provide support to all committees and activities.
3. Provide strategic direction to church programs.
4. Provide an opportunity for communication, sharing and networking among committees and activities.
5. Coordinate the preparation and submission of budget requests for committees and activities.
6. Organize an activities fair to be held in September of each church year for the purpose of informing our members and friends about the programs and activities available at UUCC and encourage their participation.

Standing committees are those identified in the by-laws: [list]. Program committees and activities are established by the congregation to plan, organize and implement other programs and activities of the church not identified in the by-laws. Program committees are established and disbanded by the Program Council as it deems necessary subject to confirmation by the Board of Directors. Program committee chairpersons are selected and replaced when necessary by the committee unless otherwise selected or replaced by the Program Council.
